ENTRIES = ++PTF (RO85848)</p> <p>COPY NEWMEMBER DOES NOT WORK FOR MEMBER(*)</p> <p>PROBLEM DESCRIPTION:</p> <p>When running a CAWABATC job to copy all members from an input PDS to an output PDS with the NEWMEMBER(pattern) parameter, none of the members are effectively renamed.</p> <p>This happens with both single and complex member list: MEMBER(*) or MEMBER(A*,X*,*) for example.</p> <p>SYMPTOMS:</p> <p>The member names in the output PDS are the same than in the input PDS; no renames occurred.</p> <p>No warning or error messages are returned to the user.</p> <p>IMPACT:</p> <p>The COPY command with the NEWMEMBER parameter fails when trying to copy to whole PDS library.</p> <p>CIRCUMVENTION:</p> <p>Specify the parameter MEMBER(%*) instead of MEMBER(*).</p> <p>PRODUCT(S) AFFECTED:</p> <p>CA File Master Plus Base Component Release 9.0 CA File Master Plus Base Component Release 9.1</p> <p>Related Problem:</p> <p>FMMVS 1340</p> <p>Copyright (C) 2015 CA. ENTRIES = ++PTF (RO86066)</p> <p>REP IS NOT AN ABBREVIATION FOR REPLACE</p> <p>PROBLEM DESCRIPTION: When running a CAWABATC job to replace record value using REP keyword which is abbreviation for REPLACE, error message CAWA1012E KEYWORD IN ROR ERROR is issued and job ends.</p> <p>SYMPTOMS: Job ends with error message 'CAWA1012E KEYWORD IN ERROR => REP'.</p> <p>IMPACT: The batch job fails.</p> <p>CIRCUMVENTION: Use the full keyword REPLACE.</p> <p>PRODUCT(S) AFFECTED: CA File Master Plus Base Component Release 9.0 CA File Master Plus Base Component Release 9.1</p> <p>Related Problem: FMMVS 1343</p> <p>Copyright (C) 2015 CA. ENTRIES = ++PTF (RO86519)</p> <p>INCORRECT SCROLLING IN AN INITIAL EMPTY SF DISPLAY</p> <p>PROBLEM DESCRIPTION: In a SF mode Edit session message 'Data set is empty' is displayed in the upper right corner of the screen and the command that was just entered re-displays in the command line.</p> <p>SYMPTOMS: The user starts an Edit session against an empty data set in Character mode. Message 'Data set is empty' is set in the upper right corner of the screen. The user switches to SF mode. Message 'Bottom of data set' shows in the upper right corner of the screen. If user presses PF7 (UP) or PF8 (DOWN) the message 'Data set is empty' shows again in the upper right corner of the screen and the UP or DOWN command shows in the command line. In order to issue the next command the user must clear the command line.
